Currently, the nomination process for NAHB Representatives on the 2012-15 ICC Code Development Cycle (CDC) code committees and interpretations committees is open. For a complete list of the 2012 ICC Code Committees, click here.

Among the duties required of a NAHB Representative on a Code Committee is attending the NAHB Provisions Oversight Group (POG) meetings in Washington, D.C. prior to the hearings. The purpose of these POG meetings is to review all of the proposed code changes and develop a NAHB position of support. NAHB covers the travel expense for the POG meetings.

For the hearings themselves, the Code Committee members are required to participate in pre-hearing conference calls, review the proposals assigned to them, and attend the Code Development Hearings. Depending on the Code Committee, the time to travel and attend the hearings is two to three days. The IRC Building/Energy Code Committee hearings may last as long as five days. ICC Committee/Council members travel at ICC's expense when participating at these meetings.

The 2012-15 CDC is the first cycle where the hearings are divided into Group A and B, with separate hearings in 2012 and 2013. The codes being heard in 2012 are the IBC, IFGC, IMC, IPC and IPSDC. The codes being heard in 2013 are the IEBC, IECC, IFC, IGCC, IPMC, IRC, IWUIC and IZC.

The deadline to submit an application to NAHB is Thursday, May 12. To complete the application process, you will need to complete a Background Information Form that can be obtained from Steve Orlowski, NAHB program manager, Codes and Standards.
