Just prior to the holidays Broomfield distributed a summary of draft revisions to the Broomfield Standards and Specifications and the HBA forwarded to members to solicit comments and feedback. The proposed revisions are tentatively scheduled to go before City Council for first reading on January 10, with second and final reading tentatively scheduled for February 14, 2012. Lafayette Repeals its Affordable Housing Requirement

After an extended moratorium on the requirement, Lafayette city council fully and permanently repealed the requirement to construct Permanently Affordable housing units. Any Permanently Affordable housing units identified on any development's Final Plat or Final Planned Unit Development, and within any development's Community Housing Plan that has not been constructed and/or sold by the developer as of January 13, 2012, is released from the Permanently Affordable requirements. The repeal also allows owners of such units to apply to the City for release of the permanently affordable deed restriction when the owner can demonstrate having made a bona fide effort to market the Permanently Affordable unit, and an eligible household has not been found or referred to the owner by the Program Administrator. Castle Rock Utilities Department to Make Policy Revisions

In response to HBA and member feedback and concerns regarding the new water rates and fees established in the fall of 2011, the Town Utilities Department as agreed to make policy revisions concerning meter sizing and SDF calculations for residential units. Revisions will include: an adjustment in the fixture unit and gpm calculations used for toilets; changes to when the Town will require engineered calculations to demonstrate SFE on single family unites; and providing a process that allows up to 35 gpm to qualify for a ¾" meter. Two revised forms have been created to implement these changes. Sean Davin at the Town is coordinating these changes with builders and the Town's Development Services Department.
